

## 1. Basketball Tournament Rules and Regulations

The Team captains are wholly responsible to make sure that their players fully understand tournament rules and regulations. Basketball rules are regulated using NCAA standards.

1. No maximum players on each team. Finalized roster must be approved by the Tournament staff prior to the first game.
2. Teams must have Jerseys of same color and must be numbered. (Alternative jerseys will be given if player does not have a jersey).
3. 20 minute halves. Clock will stop last 2 minutes in the second half only.
4. Players will be given 5 fouls per game.
5. Bonus shots (1-and-1) will be given after the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul, and the team will be in double bonus (2 shots) after the 10<sup>th</sup> team foul, per half.
6. Each team will be given 2 time outs the entire regular game play and they will not carry over. In case of OT, 1 extra time out will be given.
7. The inbound pass will be passed in wherever the Time-Out is taken. Advancement of the ball is allowed only during the last 2 minutes of the second half.
8. 5 minutes will be given for over time. During OT, 3<sup>rd</sup> team foul will be bonus, 5<sup>th</sup> team foul will be double bonus. For every OT after the first OT, it will consist of 3 minutes.
9. Jump ball at Start of game and Start of OT.
  - For Overtime, possessions will reset.
10. 30 points mercy rule is in effect for last 5 minutes of the game. 50 points will be highest differential.
11. Technical fouls will be given to any player/team for behavior established in signed agreement. It will count as a personal foul. Technical foul is automatic two points and ball for the opposing team.
  - 2 Techs = out of the game
  - 4 techs = 2 games suspension
  - 6 techs = out of league
- 12.1 Flagrant Foul (all refs must agree): player will be Out of game
  - Pushing from behind
  - Player didn't go for the ball
  - Anything that's above the head
